Don't Forget!

- Refillable **Water** Bottle
- **Face covering** (face mask, bandana, face gaiter, etc).
- Bring **credit card** to place on file until the vehicle is returned.
- Drivers **MUST** be at least **18 years of age** to operate vehicles and **MUST** provide a valid **Driver's License** at check-in.
- Covered **closed toe footwear** is **REQUIRED** for all tours and during water activities (applicable tours only).

Water activities are subject to change at any time due to weather conditions.

- **Extended Riding Times** (in comparison to other tour options) - Trek across all 3 trail systems along Kipu Ranch.
- **Movie Locations** – This tour highlights many movie locations for amazing photo and video taking opportunity.
- **Waterfall Lookout** – Drive right up to our private waterfall. Walk to waterfall is a moderate hike on uneven ground, approximately 75 meters down and back up. Short hike is optional for those that would like to view waterfall from top.

Preparing for Your Adventure

- Guests may get dusty or muddy depending on weather conditions. We recommend guests wear dark clothing or clothing they don't mind getting stained by Kauai's red dirt. Clothing (top and bottom) is required to participate in tour.
- We recommend a long sleeve top and long pants in place of using bug spray. If using bug spray, we recommend using an all natural locally made product. An all natural Kaua'i made bug spray is available for purchase at check-in.
- We recommend extra change of clothes, reef-safe sunscreen, towel and a camera with a case for dust, mud and water protection (no drones).
- We encourage guests to bring a reusable water bottle. A water refill station is available at check-in. All vehicles are equipped with standard sized cup holders.
- Valuable items not recommended on tour. Tour operator will not be held responsible if lost, stolen or damaged. No personal storage available on site.

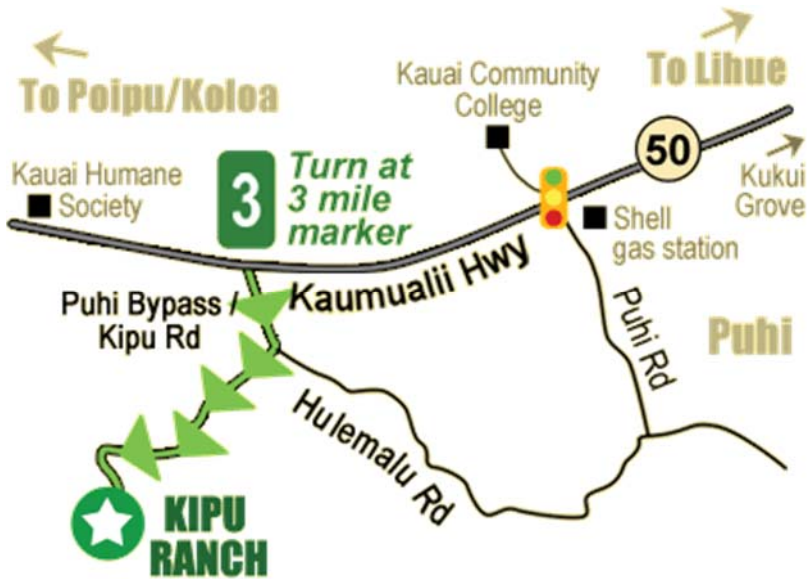
Guest Policy

- All guests are required to wear a **face covering** (face mask, bandana, face gaiter, etc) during check in and at any time where they are unable to safely physically distance (6 feet or more) from staff and other guests outside of their party.
- Any person experiencing a temperature of **100.4 degrees and higher and/or experiencing flu-like symptoms** should not participate and will be rescheduled or issued a full refund.

- **Digital Waivers** MUST be completed by all participants prior to arrival to support a contactless check-in process. A link to the digital waiver form will be included in reservation confirmation. No printing required.
- All drivers MUST be at least **18 years of age to operate vehicles** and MUST provide a valid Driver's License.
- No recent surgeries, **pregnant women**, or any **serious health conditions** allowed on tours. Serious neck/back/knee problems not recommended.
- **Covered closed toe footwear** is REQUIRED for all tours and during water activities (applicable tours only). Water activities are subject to water conditions at the time of the tour.
- **Drug and alcohol** use is not permitted before or during tours. Impaired participation is not allowed for your safety.
- Age restrictions apply: Ages 9 + are welcome to participate.
- For your safety, Kipu Ranch Adventures will provide **helmets and goggles**. Guests are welcome to bring their own helmet or **eye protection**, such as sunglasses, if preferred.
- Guests are required to **arrive on-time**. Tours operate on schedule and cannot wait for late guests. The option to reschedule will be presented to late arrivals.
- Tours operate **rain or shine** with the exception of severe weather conditions.
- If you are booking on behalf of another person or group, it is your responsibility to **inform each participant** of these restrictions.

From the North (Princeville) & East (Kapaa & Wailua) Shores:

Head SOUTH on Hwy. 56 into the town of Lihue, here Hwy. 56 runs into Hwy. 50. Follow Hwy. 50 thru the town of Puhi. Turn LEFT at the 3 mile marker (KIPU sign). Go ¼ mile and take the first RIGHT (KIPU road, also NO OUTLET sign), cross over small bridge, and follow to the top. Take a RIGHT at our sign and pull into the first driveway. DO NOT go past the pine trees or monument.

From the South (Poipu or Koloa) & West (Waimea) Shores:

Head EAST towards the town of Lihue on Hwy. 50. Turn RIGHT after the Kauai Humane Society (Animal Shelter) on the "LIHUE ALTERNATE" road. Go ¼ mile and take the first RIGHT (KIPU road, also NO OUTLET sign), cross over small bridge, and follow to the top. Take a RIGHT at our sign and pull into the first driveway. DO NOT go past the pine trees or monument.
